

PROPOSED STOPPING OF PORTION OF AIKMANS ROAD

Public Notice having been given that pursuant to the provisions of Section 319(h) and 345(1)(a)(i) of the Local Government Act 1974, the Christchurch City Council has resolved to stop that portion of Aikmans Road, as described in the Schedule hereto.

Reason for the portion of road to be stopped

The Council has received a request from the adjoining owners at No. 114 Aikmans Road for the purchase of the land which is no longer required by Council for road widening purposes.

Purpose to which the stopped road will be put

The portion of road when stopped, will be sold to the adjoining owners pursuant to Section 345(a)(l) of the Local Government Act 1974 and amalgamated with their Certificate of Title pursuant to Section 345(2) of the Local Government Act 1974.

This notice refers to a portion of legal road occupied by the owners of No. 114 Aikmans Road.

The above mentioned plan may be inspected during normal office hours at the Property Unit, fourth floor, Civic Offices, 163 Tuam Street or at any Christchurch City Council Service Centre.

Persons wishing to object to this proposal must lodge their objection in writing, and addressed to Property Manager, Christchurch City Council, Civic Offices, 163 Tuam Street, or posted to P O Box 237, Christchurch, to arrive no later than 4:00 pm on Wednesday the 28th day of November 2001.
