**AMENDED DECLARATION OF
RESULT OF ELECTION OF
HEATHCOTE WARD MEMBERS OF
SPREYDON/HEATHCOTE
COMMUNITY BOARD**

At its first meeting following the 2001 triennial general elections the Christchurch City Council appointed Councillors Oscar Alpers, Barry Corbett and Sue Wells as appointed members of the Spreydon/Heathcote Community Board. Councillor Alpers, having been elected as an elected member of the Board representing the Heathcote Ward, subsequently resigned his position as an elected member of the Board, thus allowing his appointment as an appointed member of the Board to become effective pursuant to the provisions of section 101ZQ(4)(b) of the Local Government Act 1974.

Section 101ZQ(4A)(a) of the Local Government Act 1974 provides that any vacancy in the position of member of a Community Board occurring in these circumstances must be filled by the election of the highest polling unelected candidate.

The highest polling unelected candidate at the triennial election for this issue was Mr Paul de Spa (Green for Christchurch 2021). Pursuant to section 86 of the Local Electoral Act 2001 I therefore declare the said Paul de Spa to be elected as a Heathcote Ward member of the Spreydon/Heathcote Community Board.
