## NOTICE OF TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES IN THE VICINITY OF JADE STADIUM

### Roads to be Closed

This closure will apply to all vehicular traffic with the exception of emergency service vehicles.

## THE CHRISTCHURCH CITY COUNCIL'S SUCCESSFUL WARMER HOMES INCENTIVE PROGRAMME FINISHING ON JUNE 30 2002.

Act now if you are planning on removing, replacing or sealing up an open fireplace or coal burner. You could be eligible for a grant to help with insulation costs, a grant for disabling an open fire or coal burner and a grant towards the installation costs of a new approved heating appliance.

Not only will you be helping yourself and your family by creating a warmer, dryer home environment, but also helping cut down the level of air pollution in Christchurch.

If you are a homeowner who has a current Community Services Card and are willing to seal, remove or replace your existing open fire place or coal burner that is being used as the main source of heating in the main living area of your home, then you will need to act now before 31 May 2002.

Applications must be registered with the Programme Administrator on or before 31 May, 2002. Any registrations after this date will not be accepted for the Warmer Homes Incentive Programme.

Those who have registered must have all installations completed by June 30 2002. Grant allocation for installations will not be rebated after this date.
