Roads Proposed to be Closed

- Colombo Street between Kilmore Street and Cathedral Square
- Armagh Street between Durham Street South and Manchester Street
- Gloucester Street between Gloucester Street South and Manchester Street
- Worcester Street between Oxford Terrace and Cathedral Square
- The north-east and north-west quadrants of Cathedral Square

Proposed Period of Closure

From midnight on Friday 8 March until 8am on Sunday 10 March 2002

This closure is proposed to be made under paragraph 11(e) of the Tenth Schedule of the Local Government Act 1974. The proposed closure will apply to all vehicular traffic with the exception of emergency service vehicles. Goods service vehicles, buses and taxis will have access to the roads described above between 6pm on Saturday 9 March and 8am on Sunday 10 March. During the event limited access will also be provided for motorists travelling to and from parking buildings and for taxis and buses servicing hotels within the area affected by the event.
