

CHRISTCHURCH PROPOSED CITY PLAN NOTICE OF REQUIREMENT FOR DESIGNATION ROADING WORKS, BLENHEIM ROAD DEVIATION

The Christchurch City Council advises that it is issuing a new requirement for "Roading Works" designation to enable the construction of the Blenheim Road deviation. The proposed new road will become a direct link between Blenheim Road and Moorhouse Avenue and will replace the existing length of Blenheim Road between Mandeville Street/Picton Avenue and Deans Avenue.

The corridor of land required for the designation is generally 23.5 metres wide running generally north-west to the south-east from the intersection of Blenheim Road and Picton Avenue through to the western end of Moorhouse Avenue.

The Notice of Requirement, the accompanying information, maps and diagrams showing the affected area and the proposed road alignment may be inspected during normal opening hours at any of the Council's Service Centre offices. For details of your nearest Service Centre, please telephone 371 1999.

Any person can make a submission on this Notice of Requirement by lodging a written submission at any of the Council's Service Centre offices. For details of your nearest Service Centre, please telephone 371 1999. Submissions must be in writing and in the prescribed form (Form 6A) in the Resource Management (Forms) Regulations 1991 or similar. Forms are available from the offices listed above. Once all submissions have been received, a Council hearing will be arranged to consider these submissions and a recommendation and then the decision will be made. Anyone who has made a submission will have the right to attend the hearing and present his or her submission.

The closing date for submissions is Friday, 1 March 2002, at Civic Offices and any other Council Office before 5.00pm.
