**NOTICE OF REQUIREMENT FOR A  
DESIGNATION - RESIDENTIAL CENTRE,  
HORSESHOE LAKE ROAD**

The Christchurch City Council has received a Notice of Requirement for a Designation from the Minister of Social Services and Employment. The requirement is for a Care and Protection Residential Centre – South and is limited to:

- (a) The placement of up to 20 children and young persons for the purpose of providing care (including secure care), protection, control and treatment; and
- (b) Ancillary educational, recreational, therapeutic, administrative, cultural and visitor accommodation facilities; and
- (c) Earthworks ancillary to the construction of the Residential Centre, including buildings, landscaping, outdoor recreation areas, and access.

The notice relates to the property at 20 Horseshoe Lake Road, Burwood (being part of the current Kingslea Centre site).

The Notice of Requirement and the accompanying information may be inspected during normal opening hours at any of the Council's Service Centre offices. For details of your nearest Service Centre, please telephone 371 1999.

Any person can make a submission on this Requirement by lodging it at any of the Council's Service Centre offices. Submissions must be in writing and in the prescribed form (Form 6A) in the Resource Management (Forms) Regulations 1991 or similar. Forms are available from the Service Centre offices.

Every person who makes a submission must serve a copy of the submission on the Requiring Authority at the following address: Minister of Social Services and Employment, Crown Law Office, PO Box 5012, Wellington, Attn: B H Arthur.

The closing date for submissions is **Friday, 22 March 2002, before 5.00pm** at any Council Office.
