

PROPOSED EXCHANGE OF RESERVE FOR OTHER LAND

REG MUIRSON SUBDIVISION – SHORTLAND STREET / WAINONI ROAD, AND CLASSIFICATION OF THE PROPOSED RESERVE

The Christchurch City Council gives public notice that it intends to pass a resolution to authorise and give effect to the following actions:

1) Pursuant to Section 15 of the Reserves Act 1977, the exchange of that area of public reserve described in schedule A for that area of land held in fee simple described in schedule B.

The new reserve will have a wide frontage to Wainoni Road, and provide a pedestrian link through to the Aranui High School playing fields, by abutting up to the school boundary.

Schedule A

Reserve 4438 DP 11921 containing 6207 square metres, comprised in Certificate of Title 47C/272 which is held for a recreation reserve, shown as Section 5 on SO Plan 304252 (subject to survey) situated at 25 Shortland Street known as Shortland Street Playground.

Schedule B

All those parcels of land shown as Sections 1,2,3 & 4 on SO Plan 304252 containing 11509m2 (subject to survey) being Part Lot 24 DP 878, Part Lots 3,5 & 6 DP 15696, Pt Lot 24 DP 878 and Lot 4 DP 15696 situated at 172 Wainoni Road.

2) Pursuant to Section 16 (2A) of the Reserves Act 1977, to classify the proposed reserve described in schedule B as a Recreation Reserve as defined in Section 17 of the Act.
