PROPOSED STOPPING OF PORTIONS OF MAFFEYS ROAD

Reason for the portion of road to be stopped

The Council has received a request from the adjoining owners at No 43 and 45 Maffey's Road, for the purchase of the land which is no longer required by Council for road widening purposes.

Purpose to which the stopped road will be put

The portions of road when stopped, will be sold to the adjoining owners pursuant to Section 345(1)(a)(i) of the Local Government Act 1974 and amalgamated with their certificates of title pursuant to Section 345(2) of the Local Government Act 1974.

This notice refers to portions of legal road occupied by the owners of No 43 and 45 Maffey's Road.

The above mentioned plan may be inspected during normal office hours at the Property Unit, Fourth Floor, Civic Offices, 163 Tuam Street or at any Christchurch City Council Service Centre.

Persons wishing to object to this proposal must lodge their objection in writing, and addressed to the Property Manager, Christchurch City Council, Civic Offices, 163 Tuam Street, or posted to P O Box 237, Christchurch to arrive no later than 4:00 pm on Monday 20 May 2002.

Persons may also forward a submission in favour of the proposal to support the Council's action.
