

# **SCARBOROUGH FARM PARK CONSERVATION MANAGEMENT REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR A LICENCE TO GRAZE SHEEP**

Scarborough Farm Park is a recreation reserve administered by the Council under the provisions of the Reserves Act 1977. The Park is bounded by Evans Pass Road and lies north and south of the Summit Road adjoining Godley Head reserve to the east. As part of the Port Hills Reserves, this Park is managed primarily for conservation of indigenous grass species, recreation and visual values. To avoid further deterioration of indigenous vegetation the Council wants to grant a sheep-grazing licence as a conservation management tool, primarily to conserve the ecological values of the tussock grassland.

The council invites proposals from interested parties for a licence to graze sheep on the land described in the schedule below for a maximum period (including renewals) of 5 years.

## **Schedule**

163 hectares approximately being part Lot 1 DP 4807, Lots 1,2 & 3 DP 54492. and Pt Lot 2 DP 10127.

Proposals are to be in accordance with the document entitled "Request for Proposals for Gazing Licence-Scarborough Farm Park dated 8 May 2002 (RFP No 01/02-242) and must be received by 12 noon on Wednesday 12 June 2002.
