

DOG REGISTRATION 2002/2003

IN ACCORDANCE with the provisions of the Dog Control Act 1996, the Christchurch City Council has prescribed the following fees to be paid for dogs required to be registered in its district for the registration year commencing 1 July 2002.

[*] **GUIDE DOG FOR THE BLIND** - is a dog certified by the Royal New Zealand Foundation for the Blind as being a guide dog or a dog under training as a guide dog.

[**] **COMPANION DOG** - is a dog certified as a Companion dog by the Top Dog Companion Trust.

[***] **HEARING EAR DOG** - is a dog certified by the Hearing Dogs for Deaf People New Zealand Trust as a Hearing Ear Dog or a dog under training as such. (This concession applies in respect of one dog only per household).

[****] **OWNERS GRANTED RESPONSIBLE DOG OWNER STATUS**, - (granted prior to 30 April 2002) are required to register all dogs in their possession or care by 30 June 2002 in order to obtain any rebate offered by the Council on the dog control fee.

[#] **SPAYED/NEUTERED DOGS**, - Evidence in the form of a veterinary certificate, or a declaration from the owner to the effect that the dog is spayed or neutered will be required, where the fact is not already recorded on the Council's dog register.

[##] **A DOG CLASSIFIED AS DANGEROUS**, is a dog so classified under section 31 of the Dog Control Act 1996.

[###] **'ALL OTHER DOGS'**, are dogs not included in the specific categories above of Responsible Dog Owner Status, Neutered/Spayed dogs, Dangerous dogs, Hearing Ear dogs, Companion dogs, or Guide Dogs for the Blind.

NOTE: Where the Responsible Dog Owner Status is held by an owner, failure to register by the due date (on or before the 30 June) will cause the status to be lost and the owner will be disqualified from obtaining such status for two years. Fee concessions will not apply after 30 June.

8. APPLICATION TO REGISTER A DOG:

The Dog Control Act 1996 provides that every person who owns a dog shall make an application to the Council in whose district the dog is ordinarily kept, to register the dog not later than the 1st day of every registration year. The 2002/2003 registration year begins on 1st July 2002.

Application to register a dog must be made on the form provided by the Council and signed by the owner, or his/her agent. Forms have been mailed to all known dog owners.

- (a) Where an unregistered dog is purchased or otherwise acquired, the application to register the dog shall be made forthwith or, on or before the date on which the dog attains the age of 3 months, whichever is the later.
- (b) Details necessary for application:
 - (i) Name, address, date of birth and telephone number of the owner of the dog
 - (ii) Address at which the dog is ordinarily kept
 - (iii) Description of the dog including the name, breed, colour, age, sex (including whether the dog is neutered or not), and any distinguishing marks
 - (iv) A description of any tattoo or other permanent identification on the dog.No dog is deemed to be registered until the appropriate fee has been paid in full and a receipt and disc issued.
- (c) No fees are payable in respect to any transfers of ownership, or changes of address, however notification in writing of such changes is required within 14 days.
- (d) Where any dog is required to be registered under Clause 8(a) on or after the 1st day of August in any year, the fee payable shall be one twelfth of the appropriate annual fee for each complete month remaining in the registration year after the date of such requirement.

9. REFUND ON DEATH OF DOG:

- (a) A declaration, with evidence of the death, is necessary in respect of all claims made under subclause 9(b). Declaration forms may be obtained from any Council Service Centre.
- (b) Where the fee for the registration of any dog for any year is paid and the dog dies before the commencement of, or during that year, the Council will refund upon written request, a portion of the fee. In the case of a dog that dies before the commencement of the year, the refund would be the full fee paid, and in the case of a dog that dies during the year, the appropriate part of that fee. The part fee refundable is one twelfth of the fee paid for each complete month remaining in the registration year after the date on which the application for refund is received.
- (c) Where a registered dog is transferred from one district to another within New Zealand, the registration remains in force. No refund is made as a result of the transfer, and the dog is not required to be re-registered in the new area until 1 July next.

10. CHARGES FIXED BY COUNCIL FOR DOG RELATED SERVICES TO APPLY FROM 1 JULY 2002

(a) Licence to keep two or more dogs

The above charges are non refundable.

(b) Poundage Fees and Charges

Fee for the 1st impounding of any dog	\$45.00
Fee for the 2nd impounding of the same dog within 2 years of the 1st impounding	\$70.00
Fee for the 3rd or subsequent impounding of the same dog within 1 year of the 2nd impounding	\$110.00
Sustenance charge per day or part thereof	\$7.00
Destruction and disposal charge for impounded dog	\$35.00
Adoption fee of a dog from the City Dog Shelter	\$25.00

(c) Seizure of registered dog

Fee for the seizure of a registered dog (Subject to the dog being returned to its owner and not impounded)	\$25.00
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(d) Sale of Collars

Large 32 mm wide	\$9.00
Large 25 mm wide	\$8.00
Medium	\$7.00
Small	\$6.00
