PROPOSED STOPPING OF PORTION OF BARTON STREET/BAMFORD STREET

Public Notice having been given that pursuant to the provisions of Section 319(h) and 342(1)(a) of the Local Government Act 1974, the Christchurch City Council has resolved to stop that portion of legal road, as described in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

Portion of Bamford Street and Barton Street being all that parcel of land situated in the City of Christchurch as shown as 'Road to be Stopped' and described as follows:

Reason for the portion of road to be stopped

The reason for this road stopping is to legally restrict vehicle access onto Bamford Street from Barton Street. The physical stopping of the street will be carried out at the time of the construction of the Jubilee Street extension.

PURPOSE TO WHICH THE STOPPED ROAD WILL BE PUT

The portion of road when stopped will be held by the Council in fee simple and used for landscaping purposes pursuant to Section 345(b) of the Local Government Act 1974.

The above mentioned plan may be inspected during normal office hours at the Property Unit, fourth floor, Civic Offices, 163 Tuam Street or at any Christchurch City Council Service Centre.

Persons wishing to object to this proposal must lodge their objection in writing, and addressed to Property Manager, Christchurch City Council, Civic Offices, 163 Tuam Street, or posed to P.O. Box 237, Christchurch, to arrive no later than 4:00 pm on Wednesday 21 day of August 2002.

Persons may also forward a submission in favour of the proposal to support the Council's action.
