



PROPOSED LEASES OF RESERVE THE SCOUT ASSOCIATION OF NEW ZEALAND

The Council has conditionally approved building extensions to the existing Scout Halls on Halswell and Marshland Domains. The Halswell Group need to cater for increased use of their facility while the Marshland Group require further room for equipment storage. To accommodate the proposed building extensions the present site occupations will need to be increased.

This is public notice that the Council intends to grant The Scout Association of New Zealand (as the parent body), new leases for the total site covered by the existing buildings and proposed extensions under Section 54 (1) (b) of the Reserves Act 1977, in respect to;
