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RICHMOND PARK PROPOSED LEASE – MARIAN COLLEGE

The Council has conditionally approved an application from Marian College to relocate two prefab classroom buildings to an adjacent site on the north end of Richmond Park. The College requires a temporary site on which to locate the classrooms while two new two storey classroom accommodation blocks are being constructed on the vacated sites .Because of the building layout within the school grounds it is not possible to relocate these buildings to another site on the College property. On completion of the building programme the prefab buildings will be removed from the Park.

This is public notice that the Council intends to grant the Roman Catholic Bishop of the Diocese of Christchurch, a lease under Section 73 of the Reserves Act 1977, of approximately 755 square metres of part Reserve 4804 on which to locate and use two prefabricated school classrooms while the College building programme is being carried out The proposed lease will be for a maximum term of 2 years.
