## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF HEBERDEN AVENUE AND SCARBOROUGH ROAD

The following sections of Heberden Avenue and Scarborough Road will be temporarily closed to all vehicular traffic during the periods shown, to allow rock face stabilising work to be undertaken:

### Roads to be Closed

Heberden Avenue between Scarborough Road and Nayland Street.

Scarborough Road from Heberden Avenue to the second hairpin on Scarborough Road.

### Periods of Closure

From Tuesday 30 July 2002 to Thursday 1 August 2002 (both dates inclusive), during the following times:

These closures will apply to all vehicular traffic, and will affect all residents of Scarborough and Taylors Mistake.

## PROPOSED STOPPING OF PORTION OF BARTON STREET/BAMFORD STREET

Public Notice is hereby given that pursuant to the provisions of Section 319(h) and 342(1)(a) of the Local Government Act 1974, the Christchurch City Council has resolved to stop that portion of legal road, as described in the Schedule hereto.

### Reason for the portion of road to be stopped

The reason for this road stopping is to legally restrict vehicle access onto Bamford Street from Barton Street. The physical stopping of the street will be carried out at the time of the construction of the Jubilee Street extension.

### PURPOSE TO WHICH THE STOPPED ROAD WILL BE PUT

The portion of road when stopped will be held by the Council in fee simple and used for landscaping purposes pursuant to Section 345(b) of the Local Government Act 1974.
