## **PUBLIC NOTICE OF RIGHT TO DEMAND A POLL AND COUNCIL RESOLUTION ON ELECTORAL SYSTEM**

Electors of the Christchurch City Council have the right to demand a poll on the electoral system, First Past the Post or Single Transferable Vote, to be used for the next two triennial general elections of the Council and its community boards to be held in October 2004 and October 2007.

The Christchurch City Council has resolved that the First Past the Post (FPP) electoral system will be used for the 2004 triennial general election of the Christchurch City Council and Christchurch Community Boards.

A valid demand for a poll must:

- Specify the electoral system, First Past the Post or Single Transferable Vote, to be used at the October 2004 and October 2007 Council and community board elections; and
- Be made in writing; and
- Be signed by a number of electors equal to or greater than 5% of the number of electors enrolled as eligible to vote at the October 2001 triennial general election of the Christchurch City Council (this will require at least 11,404 elector signatures); and
- Be delivered to the principal office of the Christchurch City Council, located at 163 Tuam Street, Christchurch, by no later than 5pm on Friday 13 December 2002, being 90 days after the publication of this notice.

Every elector who signs a demand for a poll must also set out his or her full name and the address for which he or she is qualified as an elector of the Christchurch City Council.
