**DECISION ON REQUIREMENT FOR
A DESIGNATION,
RESIDENTIAL CENTRE,
HORSESHOE LAKE ROAD**

The Minister of Social Services and Employment has advised the Christchurch City Council of his decision to accept the Council's recommendation on the designation requirement for the Care and Protection Residential Centre – South with some amendments to the conditions, which the requirement is subject to. The designation requirement relates to the property at 20 Horseshoe Lake Road, Burwood (being part of the current Kingslea Residential Centre site subject to a separate designation requirement).

The decision and the accompanying information may be inspected during normal opening hours at any of the Council's Service Centre offices. For details of your nearest Service Centre, please telephone 941 8999.

Section 174 of the Resource Management Act 1991 provides that any person who made a submission on the requirement may appeal the Minister's decision to the Environment Court within 15 working days of receiving the decision.
