NOTICE OF TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES IN THE VICINITY OF JADE STADIUM

The following roads will be temporarily closed to ordinary vehicular traffic for the period shown, to assist with traffic and crowd control during the NPC semi-final game Canterbury versus Auckland being held at Jade Stadium.

Roads to be Closed

Stevens Street between Wilsons Road and Falsgrave Street
Lancaster Street between Stevens Street and Moorhouse Avenue
Falsgrave Street at Iversen Terrace
Lismore Street at Wilsons Road

Period of Closure

Between 6pm and 10.30pm on Friday 18 October 2002
This closure will apply to all vehicular traffic with the exception of emergency service vehicles.

NOTICE OF TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES FOR PARK TO PIER BIKE RIDE 2002

The following roads will be temporarily closed to ordinary vehicular traffic for the period shown, during the holding of the Penny Sport Cycles Park to Pier Bike Ride 2002:

Event Route

Riders will leave North Hagley Park via the Armagh Street bridge and progress along the following streets to New Brighton: Armagh Street, Madras Street, Barbadoes Street, Kilmore Street, Avonside Drive, Kerrs Reach, Avonside Drive, Hulverstone Drive (cycle path), Bexley Road (cycle path), Pages Road, Hawke Street and finishing on Marine Parade.

Traffic is advised to avoid Armagh Street between 10am and 11am on Sunday 20 October as there will be minor traffic delays during this time.

Roads to be Closed

(a) Armagh Street bridge (entrance to the Botanic Gardens car park)
Park Terrace (corner Kilmore Street for south-bound traffic)
Rolleston Avenue (corner Gloucester Street for north-bound traffic)
Armagh Street (at intersection no left-turn from Montreal Street)
Cranmer Square (corner of Kilmore Street western side)

(b) Marine Parade between Hawke Street and Beresford Street

Period of Closure

The roads listed in (a) above will be closed between 9.45am and 11am on Sunday 20 October 2002.
The section of Marine Parade described in (b) above will be closed between 8.30am and 2pm on Sunday 20 October 2002

Suggested Detours

Park Terrace and Salisbury Street intersection (detour into Salisbury Street)
Corner Marine Parade and Lonsdale Street (detour into Lonsdale Street)

These closures will apply to all vehicular traffic with the exception of emergency service vehicles.

SEA LETTUCE REMOVAL TRIALS AVON-HEATHCOTE ESTUARY (IHUTA)

- In terms of resource consent no. CRC020988 granted by Environment Canterbury to Christchurch City Council on 15 July 2002 for the purpose of carrying out sea lettuce and Gracilaria removal trials on the foreshore and bed of the estuary

LOCATION

Adjacent to the causeway, north side
McCormacks Bay
Humphreys Drive from Tidal View

NATURE OF OPERATION

Manual and/or suction hose moved manually at low tide.
Manual at low tide and/or collection net pulled to shore at high tide.
Manual and/or suction hose moved manually and/or excavator or loader operating from the top of the sea wall at low tide and/or collection net pulled to shore at high tide.
Suction hose moved manually and/or excavator operating from the top of the bank at low tide
