### NOTICE OF TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF VICTORIA PARK ROAD

The following section of Victoria Park Road will be temporarily closed for the period shown, during the holding of the "There's Something About Victoria" family picnic day being held at Victoria Park:

#### Period of Closure

### NOTICE OF TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES

The following roads will be temporarily closed on for the period shown, during the Coca Cola Christmas in the Park event to be held in North Hagley Park:

### MAKING OF CHRISTCHURCH CITY TRAFFIC AND PARKING ALTERATION BYLAW 2002

The Christchurch City Council, at an ordinary meeting held in the Civic Offices, 163 Tuam Street, Christchurch at 2pm on Thursday 21 November 2002, passed the following resolution:

"That in pursuance of the powers vested in it by the Local Government Act 1974 and the Transport Act 1962, the Christchurch City Council makes the Christchurch City Traffic and Parking Alteration Bylaw 2002."

The purpose of the bylaw is to provide for the installation of 40km/h speed limit school zones at the following locations:

- In Sparks Road outside Hoon Hay and Our Lady of Assumption Schools
- In Prestons Road outside Marshland School
- In Kirk Road and Banks Street outside Templeton School

The bylaw is proposed to come into force on 20 January 2003.
