### **TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES FOR PIPE BAND STREET MARCH**

The following roads will be temporarily closed for the period shown, during the holding of a pipe band street march:

#### **Proposed to be Closed**

Armagh Street between Oxford Terrace and Colombo Street  
Colombo Street between Armagh Street and Kilmore Street  
Cambridge Terrace from Colombo Street to the first bend thereafter

#### **Period of Closure**

Saturday 7 December 2002 between 4pm and 5pm

This closure is made under paragraph 11(e) of the Tenth Schedule of the Local Government Act 1974, and will apply to all vehicular traffic with the exception of emergency service vehicles.

### **TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SECTION OF HUMPHREYS DRIVE**

The following section of Humphreys Drive will be temporarily closed during the period shown, during the holding of a triathlon event:

#### **Road to be Closed**

Humphreys Drive between Ferry Road and Tidal View (the closure will apply to north bound traffic only, with one lane remaining open for south bound traffic)

#### **Period of Closure**

Sunday 15 December 2002 between 9am and 11am

This closure is made under paragraph 11(e) of the Tenth Schedule of the Local Government Act 1974 and will apply to all vehicular traffic with the exception of emergency service vehicles.

### **NOTICE OF LOCAL BILL - CHRISTCHURCH CITY COUNCIL (ROBERT MCDUGALL GALLERY) LAND VESTING BILL**

Notice is given that the Christchurch City Council intends to introduce into the House of Representatives the above named Bill.

The objects of the Bill are:

1. To vest land on which is situated the Robert McDougall Art Gallery, in the Christchurch City Council free from all trusts, restrictions and reservations for the Council to hold as a local purpose reserve for the purpose of a gallery for the display of art and decorative arts and crafts and ancillary purposes.
2. To empower the Council to lease, licence or let all or any part of the land on such terms and conditions as it thinks fit for the purpose stated in paragraph 1.
3. To repeal section 54 of the Reserves and others Lands Disposal and Public Bodies Empowering Act 1925.
