

MAKING OF CHRISTCHURCH CITY PUBLIC PLACES AND SIGNS BYLAW 2003

The Christchurch City Council, at an ordinary meeting held in the Civic Offices, 163 Tuam Street, Christchurch at 2pm on Thursday 24 April 2003, passed the following resolution:

“That, in accordance with the special order procedure in section 716B of the Local Government Act 1974, the Council resolve to make the Public Places and Signs Bylaw 2003, such resolution to be confirmed at the subsequent meeting of the Council on 22 May 2003.”

The purpose of the new bylaw is to make minor administrative changes to the current Christchurch City Public Places and Signs Bylaw 1992, principally in respect of delegations.
