PROPOSED LEASE - EAST CHRISTCHURCH SHIRLEY CRICKET CLUB INCORPORATED AND SHIRLEY RUGBY FOOTBALL CLUB INCORPORATED

The Council has conditionally approved an application from the East Christchurch Shirley Cricket Club and the Shirley Rugby Football Club to lease 346m2 of North Burwood Park for the purposes of extending the existing pavilion. The East Christchurch Shirley Cricket Club Incorporated owns the present pavilion. The reason for the proposed extension is to accommodate the use of the pavilion by the Shirley Rugby Football Club, who seeks to relocate their club rooms to the park. Both clubs have reached agreement to jointly own, manage, and use the existing pavilion.

This is public notice that the Council intends to grant the East Christchurch Shirley Cricket Club Incorporated and the Shirley Rugby Football Club Incorporated a lease under Section 54(1) (b) of the Reserves Act 1977 over 346 square metres of Burwood Park for a period of 1 day less than 20 years. The granting of a lease will also be contingent on the Minister of Conservation approving the proposal.
