PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR SOLID AND HAZARDOUS WASTE 1998

The Council at its ordinary meeting on 22 March 2001 resolved to amend the vision and goal contained within the above plan, originally adopted by the Council in 1998 pursuant to the Local Government Act 1974.

The vision and goal within the current plan are stated to be:

Vision *“To minimise the impact of solid waste on the environment.”*

Goal *“To reduce the rate per person of solid waste going into the landfill as follows, taking account of real costs:*

- *By 14% by the year 2000*
- *By 30% by the year 2005, and*
- *By 100% by the year 2020 or by the time the new regional landfill is filled.”*

At its meeting on 22 March 2001 the Council resolved to give public notice of its intention to amend the current vision and goal in the above plan to read:

Vision *“Zero waste to landfill as soon as possible, taking into account social, legal and economic constraints.”*

Goal ● *“A minimum reduction of 50% of waste to landfill from 2000 to 2020.*
● *Zero organics to landfill by 2010.”*
