

PROPOSAL TO CHANGE NAME OF UNFORMED PART OF MAJOR HORN BROOK ROAD TO UPPER MAJOR HORN BROOK ROAD

The Christchurch City Council, at an ordinary meeting held in the Civic Offices, 163 Tuam Street, Christchurch at 2pm on Thursday 24 May 2001, adopted the following resolution: "That the name of the unformed part of Major Hornbrook Road shown on the attached plan be changed to "Upper Major Hornbrook Road".

The reason for the proposed change is that Signal Hill Road is being physically constructed over an unformed part of Major Hornbrook Road. If this part was left as Major Hornbrook Road, it would create confusion as there would then be two parts to Major Hornbrook Road.
