## **PROPOSAL TO CHANGE NAME OF UNFORMED PART OF GRIMSEYS ROAD TO RIVERWOOD BOULEVARD**

The Christchurch City Council, at an ordinary meeting held in the Civic Offices, 163 Tuam Street, Christchurch at 2pm on Thursday 28 June 2001, adopted the following resolution:

“That the name of the unformed part of Grimseys Road shown on the attached plan be changed to “Riverwood Boulevard”.

The reason for the change relates to a new access road to a subdivision in this locality which will be formed over an unformed portion of Grimseys Road.
