PROPOSAL: To use an existing residential property as a traditional English Style Tea House offering morning and afternoon teas and lunches. A residential activity will be retained on site and the hours of operation will be Monday to Friday from 9:30am – 5:00pm. The Tea House will have seating for a maximum of 20 customers and there will be no outdoor dining. A total of two full time equivalent staff members will be employed and there will be three on-site car parks provided.
