

**7. RICCARTON/WIGRAM COMMUNITY SERVICES COMMITTEE

**1. DEPUTATION BY APPOINTMENT**

Hayley Inglis, a recipient of a Youth Development grant towards costs associated with attending the Rock and Roll Wintersun Competition held in Coolangatta in June was unable to attend the meeting as scheduled. The Committee viewed a video of Hayley and her partner, Jordan Vincent (who also received funding from this scheme) at the competition.
