## 8. NOTICE OF MOTION: PUBLIC MEETING BEALEY AVENUE RESIDENTS

To consider the following motion, notice of which as been given by Yani Johanson pursuant to Standing Order 2.16.1:

Given the concerns expressed at the public meeting on 1 November 2004 of Bealey Ave residents and others, at the nuisance generated from noisy exhausts and speeding traffic (see attached minutes); and

Noting the resolution of the Christchurch City Council on 11 November 2004 which states: "That the Council facilitate a discussion with relevant stakeholders to canvass solutions to the problem."

That the Board:

- 1. Recommend to the Council that a joint seminar with all elected members be held with the Police, LTSA, local MPs and other relevant parties to discuss a strategic citywide response to the nuisance associated with noisy vehicles.
- 2. Recommend to the Council, the establishment of a working party of key stakeholders to actively progress the issues raised in the discussion.
- 3. Seek a report from Council staff on options for dealing with the associated safety and speed issue on Bealey Avenue, including:
  - the process for establishing a static speed camera
  - using appropriate signage
  - any other potential measures
- 4. Express support to local Police for increased traffic enforcement along Bealey Avenue.
