4. LIQUOR BAN FOR ILAM AREA

The Regulatory and Consents Committee recommended in a report to the 1 July 2004 Council meeting that further consultation on alcohol related problems in the Ilam area be undertaken to determine whether a Council resolution is necessary to amend the bylaw. The Committee also recommended that a process for the amendment of the bylaw be adopted by the Council, which involved initial requests being brought before the Regulatory and Consents Committee, and then being referred to the appropriate community board before the Committee makes a recommendation to the Council regarding an amendment to the bylaw. Following the adoption of the Committee's recommendations at the 1 July 2004 Council meeting, the Committee will give consideration at this meeting to the means by which progress on liquor related issues in the Ilam area may proceed.

A copy of the submission and petition tabled during the Liquor Control Bylaw hearing process requesting the introduction in Ilam is attached. Copies of the chart presented with this submission detailing instances of alcohol related disorder in Ilam will be available at the Committee meeting.

Chairman's Recommendation:

- 1. That the Committee discuss the means by which it wishes to progress consideration of liquor related issues in the Ilam area.
- That representatives of the Police, University, local residents associations, Neighbourhood Support, the Community Advocate for the Riccarton/Wigram area, local elected members and Community Board representatives be invited to attend the Committee meeting to discuss ways in which a community discussion on the issue of disorder could usefully be facilitated.
