7. DISRAELI STREET: PARKING RESTRICTION

The purpose of this report is to seek the Board's approval to install a 30 minute parking restriction on the south side of Disraeli Street, east of Montreal Street (see attachment).

The Tile Warehouse, 106 Disraeli Street, has requested that a 30 minute time limited parking area be provided in this section of Disraeli Street to provide some short-term on-street parking for the business and retail needs of this area. On a daily basis there is a high demand for commuter parking in this area and also on days when people are attending the local auction rooms.

The proposed time limit complies with item 5 of the Parking Strategy for commercial/retail areas (including central city) parking priority on-street policy number 6G.
