9. EASTERN TERRACE: PROPOSED NO STOPPING RESTRICTION

The purpose of this report is to request that the Board approve for installation a proposed no stopping restriction in Eastern Terrace at the proposed Buxton Terrace pedestrian bridge.

The Board considered this request for a no stopping restriction at its 4 May 2004 meeting. At the meeting there was confusion over a conflict between the overhead transparency and the plan appended to the report. These issues have now been resolved.

A no stopping restriction is required in Eastern Terrace, as shown on the appended plan, to preserve adequate space for the through movement of traffic at the access ramp and new kerb, to be constructed with the new pedestrian bridge. The Consultation Leader has talked with the property owners and residents in the adjacent properties, who are all agreeable to the installation of a no stopping restriction on the east side of the road, outside their properties.

Having gained the approval of the residents, it is proposed no stopping restrictions be installed on the eastern side of Eastern Terrace opposite numbers 215 to 219.
