

8. PROPOSED NEW ROAD NAME – GILBERTHORPES ROAD

The purpose of this report is to obtain the approval by the Board of one new Road name. Road and Right of Way name approvals are delegated to Community Boards. It is important that approved names will not duplicate or be similar to existing names. All names submitted have been checked by Council and NZ Post for duplication.

157 & 161 Gilberthorpes Road – O’Donnell Waters Subdivision.

This subdivision creates twenty new residential allotments, together with a new reserve to vest in the council. Several names have been submitted, however most were considered too similar to existing names, and have not been submitted.

The name proposed is Rubicon Place. The Rubicon River is a tributary of the Waimakariri River. There is also a Rubicon Lake near Springfield. This name continues the theme of the adjoining subdivision to the south, where the names used were those of West Coast Lakes and reservoirs.

A plan of the new subdivision is **attached**.

Recommendation : That the Board consider the proposed name Rubicon Place, and approve it, if deemed appropriate.
