2. SITE VISITS

2.1 ST AIDANS - BRYNDWR

As an active member of Bryndwr Churches Community Support Society, St Aidans plays a pivotal role in supporting community services in the Bryndwr community.

Not only does St Aidans provide support programmes targeted at its own client group it also recently developed part of its building to accommodate the Bryndwr Youth Worker and has since reached agreement with the North West Mentoring Trust to provide work space for its Coordinator.

Members have been invited to meet staff of St Aidans who will outline their community support initiatives.

2.2 YOUTH FOR CHRIST

The Board is aware of the ongoing support provided through its project/discretionary funds, Community Development Funding and Strengthening Communities Support votes to the following initiatives:

- Youth for Ever
- Rock Solid
- Link

The Youth Forever Club has since grown from support provided to local residents to one of metropolitan significance. However, Youth Forever still have around 30% of their client base resident within the Fendalton/Waimairi community.

The Committee has been invited to visit Youth Forever's base at Windemere School and will be hosted by Steve Zingel and Youth Forever's community worker, Botros Morgan.

2.3 ST PATRICK'S - OUT OF SCHOOL CARE

Through the Board's Out of School Care and Community Development Scheme funding, support has been provided over a two and a half period to assist and overcome the issue of the OSP Committee having to resite their building.

The committee advises that the landscaping is now in place surrounding their facilities new site and are extremely happy with the outcome.
