The purpose of this report is to obtain the approval by the Board of names for two new roads, and one new right of way. Name approvals are delegated to Community Boards. It is important that approved names will not duplicate or be similar to existing names. All names submitted have been checked by Council and NZ Post for duplication.

STYX MILL COUNTRY CLUB SUBDIVISION, HUSSEY ROAD, PAPANUI WARD

The names Springmead Lane, Watermead Terrace and Fieldbrook Lane were submitted for this subdivision at the 3 March 2004 Board meeting, however the Board requested a meeting with the applicant to discuss the proposed names. As a result of the meeting, the applicant has now submitted three further names in substitution.

Two further stages at opposite ends of this subdivision will result in two new roads, and a formed and sealed right of way, to provide access to the new allotments being created. The countryside and waterways are the common theme established for the initial stages of the subdivision, and the applicants propose to continue the theme for these two new stages. The following names are proposed for use : 1. Rindle Lane; (Alternative Beck Lane) 2. Springbrook Lane (Alternative Springcreek Lane) 3. Millcreek Lane. (No alternative supplied)
