

19. CAMBRIDGE TERRACE CONSTRUCTION ZONE

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The purpose of this report is to seek the Board's approval for the installation of two "Construction Zones" on the north side of Cambridge Terrace just west of Montreal Street (see attached plan).

Naylor Love Construction are building 29 residential apartments in four blocks with associated underground parking at 41-43 Cambridge Terrace. They have requested that space be allocated as a "Construction Zone".

The "Construction Zones" will not only assist the operations on the site, but will also prevent damage to parked vehicles and improve the safety for the one way traffic flow from Cambridge Terrace into Montreal Street.

This is a temporary measure in an area where all day commuter parking currently occurs.

Staff

- Recommendation:**
1. That a "Construction Zone Authorised Vehicles Only" be created on the north side of Cambridge Terrace commencing at a point 48.0 metres from its intersection with Montreal Street and extend in a westerly direction for a distance of 5.5 metres.
 2. That a "Construction Zone Authorised Vehicles Only" be created on the north side of Cambridge Terrace commencing at a point 63 metres from its intersection with Montreal Street and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 14 metres.
 3. That the area revert back to all day parking on the completion of the works.
