

8. PROPOSED NEW RIGHT OF WAY NAMES

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The purpose of this report is to obtain the Board's approval to two new right-of-way names.

CRACROFT SETTLEMENT, 60 WORSLEYS ROAD

This subdivision will create 27 new residential allotments, together with a new Local Purpose Reserve of 2.436 hectares. The residential allotments will be served by three new rights-of-way. The smaller right-of-way will serve only three allotments, and does not meet the Council's criteria for naming. The other two rights-of-way do satisfy the criteria. (To be named a right of way must serve a potential of five dwellings and be formed and sealed.)

Three names have been proposed for the two rights-of-way: Dalweny Lane, Nabob Lane and Ashley Lane. Ashley Lane has the potential to be confused in an emergency with the existing name Ashby and should be declined. Nabob Lane continues the Cracroft tradition of using names from India (Nabob is described as a Governor, or a man of means.) Dalweny is the name of the Cracroft's farm in Amberley.
