#### **PURPOSE OF REPORT**

1. The purpose of this report is to obtain the Board's approval to one new right of way name.

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

- 2. The approval of proposed road and right of way names is delegated to Community Boards.
- 3. The proposed name has been checked against the Council's road name database to ensure it will not be confused with names currently in use.

# 71 Birchfield Avenue - Horncastle Homes

This subdivision creates seven new allotments, of which six allotments will gain access to Birchfield Avenue by a formed and sealed right of way. The development company propose naming the right of way after the former long standing owner, and local identity, a Mr Wrey Jury. Jury on its own may have created confusion in pronunciation with Dury Road at Harewood Airport, so the applicants have proposed the name **Wrey Jury Lane** (refer attached). The spelling of Mr Jury's name has been confirmed by checking old plan records and old Wises Directories.

#### FINANCIAL AND LEGAL CONSIDERATIONS

4. The administration fee for road naming is included as part of the subdivision consent application fee, and the cost of name plates is charged to the developer. There is no financial cost to the Council. Local Authorities have a statutory responsibility to approve road names.

# STAFF RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board approve the use of the name Wrey Jury Lane.
