### **PURPOSE OF REPORT**

1. The purpose of this report is to obtain the Boar 's approval for new roa \_names.

### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

- 2. The approval of propose roa an right of way names is elegate to community boar s.
- 3. The Sub ivision Officer has checke all propose names against the Council's roa name atabase to ensure they will not be confuse with names currently in use. The names have also been iscusse with staff at Lan Information NZ who act on behalf of the emergency services in respect to roa naming.

# (a) Christchurch City Council - Aldershot Street and Wainoni Park

A new legal roa is being constructe within Wainoni Park, running between the two en sof Al ershot Street. The Aranui Community Trust was invite to submit a list of possible names for the new roa. A list of names was submitte by the Trust, of which some were too similar in pronunciation or in the written form to names currently in use. Of the remain er, the name "Ben Rarere Avenue" was eeme the most appropriate. This was the first name submitte by the Trust. The late Ben Rarere was a former resi ent Maori War en known for his hangis, an for watching over the Wainoni Park. The Rarere Whanau have provi e their written permission for the use of Ben's name for the new roa.

### (b) Mrs NC Dixon & KB Quarries Ltd - Kingsbridge Drive

Stage 1 of this sub ivision exten s Kingsbri ge Drive an Corserlan Street, an creates a new cul- e-sac off Kingsbri ge Drive. Six new allotments will access off the new cul- e-sac. The name propose for the cul- e-sac is "Schumacher Place". E ith Amelia Schumacher was Norma Dixon's mother. Norma Dixon is the current lan owner. In 1928, E ith Amelia Schumacher marrie Horace Alexan re Donnell. They farme the lan a joining the present sub ivision until Horace's eath in 1956. E ith Amelia Donnell purchase the lan on which the "Longview" sub ivision is situate in 1942 an hel it with the farm. The lan was un erstoo to have been purchase from the Corser family. E ith Amelia continue living on the property until her eath in 1982. The Dixon family feel it woul be a fitting tribute to E ith Amelia's contribution to the viability of the farm, that a street be name after her.

# (c) Change of Road Name 5 - 37 Bexley Road

When the new expressway, ANZAC Drive was constructe three pockets of Bexley Roa remaine. The properties containe in a triangle imme lately south of Wainoni Roa were left with a single access off ANZAC Drive. Their location has prove ifficult to i entify by visitors. There have been several attempts in the past two years to change the name of the roa but until now, agreement on a replacement name by the resi ents has not been achieve. (The Council's minimum criteria before changing the name of a roa is 85% of the resi ents to be in favour of the propose change.) Previously, Avon View Place was propose an rejecte an simpler options such as changing the name of the escriptive suffix to Bexley Grove, Place, an Close etc to more clearly i entify the location of these properties i not have sufficient support from the resi ents to procee

The latest proposal offere to the resi ents was a simple choice of "Bexley Gardens" or "Falconwood Grove". Falconwoo is a locality within the Lon on Borough of Bexley. The resi ents were sent a questionnaire for completion an return by 18 October 2004. There are 18 affecte properties, an with four of them being rente so the total number of questionnaires sent out to the owners an tenants totalle 22. The questionnaires however were slow to return, an by the en of January this year, seven of them ha still not replie. An intereste resi ent then canvasse the resi ents, an obtaine further support for a change. The result is that 16 favoure "Falconwoo Grove", an four favoure "Bexley Gar ens", two others favoure "Bexley Close" an "Pahauwera Place"

(These latter two names were not an option, an the backgroun to the name Pahauwera was not provi e.). Changing a roa name involves several steps. The Boar must firstly approve the new name. The propose change is then submitte to Council, an if the Council is supportive of the change, special or er provisions are instigate which will require the propose change to be publicly notifie a minimum of two times before a secon Council meeting. If no vali objections have been receive the Council will approve the propose change at the later meeting. Once approve an effective ate for the change to take place is etermine (usually five to six weeks from approval, to allow the resi ents time to notify their change of a ress, an for the manufacture of the new name plates). The resi ents, together with critical services such as NZ Post are a vise of the ate of change.

# ( 🔪 Change of Road Name Rothesay Road to Aston Drive (Information only)

The Council has constructe a link between the northern en s of Aston Drive an Bower Avenue, within the alignment of the existing paper roa. This part of Rothesay Roa habeen unforme an the link was proving to rejuce the "bottle neck" situation in Bower Avenue an Aston Drive, an to proving a better traffic flow in the area. The Transport an City Streets Unit has requeste that as the new construction appears to be a continuation of Aston Drive, that the continuation of Aston Drive to Bower Avenue currently known as Rothesay Roa have the name change to Aston Drive. (Rothesay Roa will continue as the name for that part of the roa from Burwoo Roa to Regalwoo Close, an Queenspark Drive.) As there is no new roa name propose, this a vice is presente to the Boar for information only, no ecision is require from the Boar.

### FINANCIAL AND LEGAL CONSIDERATIONS

4. The a ministration fee for roa naming is inclue as part of the sub ivision consent application fee, an the cost of name plates is charge to the eveloper. There is no financial cost to the Council. Local Authorities have a statutory responsibility to approve roa names.

#### STAFF RECOMMENDATION

It is recommen e that the Boar approve the names "Ben Rarere Avenue", "Schumacher Place" an "Falconwoo Grove" as submitte above.
