2. CENTRAL CITY SOUTH

Introduction - Michael Theelen and Carolyn Ingles Report and Recommendations - Maurice Roers

One key element of the Central City Revitalisation Project is the development of the area to the south of Lichfield Street. To support this initiative, a planning and design workshop was held in March focusing on redevelopment in the central city south. From that workshop, a report was produced by the consultant team which outlined their recommendations on how best to spur revitalisation in the area. This seminar will review these recommendations and discuss how the Council can implement them.

3. CENTRAL CITY LANES REDEVELOPMENT

A Lanes Plan has been prepared to guide the lanes redevelopment projects in the central city, and the development of public-private partnerships with private property owners of lanes. The Plan has been prepared as part of the Central City Revitalisation Project in conjunction with the Central City Transport Concept. Four priority projects have been flagged for implementation in the short term.
