The purpose of the seminar is to present the Community Outcomes Baseline Report.

The Community Outcomes are used to guide planning and inform the Council, central government and others about the needs and aspirations in relation to the wellbeing of people in Christchurch. The Community Outcomes Monitoring Programme provides a system for tracking progress toward achieving the City's Community Outcomes. The monitoring programme sources information from many agencies and makes this available to the wider community.

As part of pulling together the progress report on the community Outcomes (required under the LGA in 2009), the Monitoring and Research Team in the Strategy and Planning Group has prepared a baseline report on Outcome trends which will be presented at the seminar. The Council approach to reporting on progress toward the Community Outcomes is primarily through a web-page format (to be presented at the seminar), showing indicator trend results, along with descriptions of community success stories. These web pages are updated frequently as new information becomes available. A summary brochure of key Outcome trends will be provided at the seminar.
