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PURPOSE OF REPORT

1. The purpose of this report is for the Metropolitan Funding Committee to consider an application, requesting a total of \$35,346.83, from the 2009/10 Metropolitan Discretionary Response Fund.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- 2. In 2009/10 the total pool available for allocation for the Metropolitan Discretionary Response Fund, as in the LTCCP, consists of \$170,000.
- 3. The purpose of the Fund is to assist community groups where the project and funding request falls outside other Council funding criteria and/or closing dates. This fund is also for emergency funding for unforeseen situations.
- 4. Applications requesting over \$15,000 require consideration by the Metropolitan Funding Committee.
- 5. To date, four applications to the Discretionary Response Fund have been received. Three of these applications are requesting over \$15,000 and therefore require a decision from the Metropolitan Funding Committee. This report deals with one of the three requests.
- 6. A decision matrix is **attached** as Appendix A to assist the Committee members in their deliberations. The decision matrix details the funding request from the applicant organisation and provides information, commentary and recommendations from staff.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

7. As per the 2009-19 LTCCP, there is currently \$170,000 available to allocate in the Metropolitan Discretionary Response Fund. In the \$750,000 reduction in grants that the Council has decided for the 2009/10 year, it has been proposed by the Grants Working Party that the amount in the Discretionary Fund be reduced to \$150,000. A decision on this will be made at the 23 July 2009 meeting of the Council. If it is agreed there is a reduction, there will still be enough in the Discretionary Fund to fund this application if the Committee wish to do so.
