- 3. At the recent South Island Secondary Schools Touch Championships the two teams qualified for the National Tournament which is being held in Palmerston North in December this year. For the third consecutive year Papanui High School has had both their Senior Girls and Senior Boys teams qualify.
- 4. Players train all year round and play in touch modules during the season as well as in the school team. The school Sports Co-ordinator advises that the applicants are all committed athletes and compete in other sports to an elite level including netball, hockey and athletics.
