PURPOSE OF REPORT

1. The purpose of this report is for the Board to consider appointing a Board member to attend the Keep New Zealand Beautiful Conference 2010 and Annual General Meeting being held in Gisborne from Friday 17 to Sunday 19 September 2010.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- 2. The Board's representative on the Keep Christchurch Beautiful Committee is Linda Stewart.
- 3. The Committee is a voluntary organisation, which aims to promote a cleaner, more beautiful environment within Christchurch, and to raise the level of awareness of what the individual can do to improve his or her community and reduce litter. Notice of the national conference has been received. Christchurch has a member on the Keep New Zealand Beautiful Board.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

- 4. The cost for one member to attend the conference is approximately \$1,198 which would be met from the Board's 2010/11 operational budget. This covers travel, accommodation and the conference registration.
- 5. The Board's 2010/11 operational budget for conferences, travel and training is \$4,550. There has been no expenditure to date from this budget.
