PURPOSE OF REPORT

The purpose of this report is to submit for information and record purposes, the following outcomes of the Burwood/Pegasus Small Grants Fund Assessment Committee meeting held on Thursday 19 August 2010 at 5pm in the Board Room, corner Beresford and Union Streets, New Brighton.

1. BURWOOD/PEGASUS SMALL GRANTS FUND 2010/11 - ALLOCATIONS
