

**10. APPLICATION TO THE RICCARTON WIGRAM 2010/11 YOUTH DEVELOPMENT SCHEME – HORNBY HIGH SCHOOL NETBALL A TEAM**

**PURPOSE OF REPORT**

1. The purpose of this report is to seek the Committee’s consideration of an application for funding from the Riccarton/Wigram 2010/11 Youth Development Scheme.

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

2. The Hornby High School Senior Girls’ Netball Team has nine members that live in the Riccarton/Wigram area that are applying for funding assistance to compete at the South Island Secondary Schools’ Netball Tournament in Blenheim from 29 August to 2 September 2010.
3. The Senior Netball Team currently play in the Canterbury Schools’ Competition on a Wednesday and in the Canterbury Netball Association under 19 grades on a Saturday. The team play in the Saturday competition under the newly established Hornby Netball Club banner. A majority of this team have been together for the past three years and have grown and developed as good quality players.
4. The South Island Tournament is an annual competition where teams from the entire South Island compete. Hornby’s immediate goal this year is to increase their ranking and be placed in the top six at the tournament. The team members are very committed players who regularly give up many hours during the term and through the holidays to train hard towards achieving their goals.
5. The team has been actively fundraising for this trip and to date they have raised \$1,086. They will continue to fundraise until they go away. The team have only applied for a contribution towards their accommodation costs for the trip.
