#### **PURPOSE OF REPORT**

1. The purpose of this report is to present six Youth Development Fund applications for funding in the 2009/2010 financial year to the Board. The **attached** table also includes the recommendations for allocation made by the Community Recreation Adviser.

- 2. **Attached** is a table summarising the six applications for funding via the Youth Development Fund. The total cost of projects is \$10,943. Three applicants are requesting the maximum amount of funding. The other three have not indicated an amount that they are seeking.

- (vi) Grace Taylor Love \$500 to attend the Australian State Basketball Championships representing New Zealand under 18's.
