PURPOSE OF REPORT

1. The purpose of this report is to present six Youth Development Fund applications for funding in the 2009/2010 financial year to the Board. The **attached** table also includes the recommendations for allocation made by the Community Recreation Adviser.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

2. **Attached** is a table summarising the six applications for funding via the Youth Development Fund. The total cost of projects is \$10,943. Three applicants are requesting the maximum amount of funding. The other three have not indicated an amount that they are seeking.
3. The Board has \$2,160 available for distribution for youth development purposes. The Community Recreation Adviser and Community Development Adviser have made recommendations totalling \$1,500. However, the final decision relating to funding belongs with the Community Board.

- (iii) Victor Daddiza - \$500 to attend the International Future Problem Solving Championship Finals in Wisconsin, USA in June 2010.
- (iv) Jemma Louise Grenfell - \$250 to participate in the New Zealand School of Dance Winter School in Wellington, in early July 2010.
- (v) Jordan Robert Barron – Decline. A similar skill development experience could be achieved closer to New Zealand.
- (vi) Grace Taylor Love - \$500 to attend the Australian State Basketball Championships representing New Zealand under 18's.
