#### **PURPOSE OF REPORT**

 The purpose of this report is to seek approval from the Board to set aside \$10,000 from its 2011/12 Discretionary Response Fund for the purpose of establishing a Youth Development Scheme.

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

- 2. The purpose of the Youth Development Scheme is to celebrate and support young people living in the Fendalton/Waimairi ward by providing financial assistance for their development. The Community Board also seeks to acknowledge young people's effort, achievement and potential excellence in the community.
- 3. The Youth Development Scheme will consider applications for the following activities:
  - Personal Development and Growth

For example leadership training, career development, Outward Bound, Spirit of Adventure, extra curricular educational opportunities.

# Representation at Events

Applicants can apply for assistance if they have been selected to represent their school, team or community at a local, national or international event or competition. This includes sporting, cultural and community events.

- 4. The following eligibility criteria must be met:
  - Age groups 12-20 years.
  - Projects must have obvious benefits for the young person and if possible the wider community.
  - Only one application per person permitted per year.
  - Applicants should be undertaking other fundraising activities and not relying solely on Community Board support.
  - Successful applicants will be required to attend a Youth Celebration event hosted by the Community Board to report back on their experiences.
- 5. Each application will be assessed by the appropriate staff member and presented to the Board for its consideration.

# FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

6. This proposal transfers funds from the Board's Discretionary Response Fund into a separate Youth Development Scheme fund. This will reduce the total amount available in the Board's Discretionary Response Fund in 2011/12 by \$10,000.
