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PURPOSE OF REPORT

1. The attached Crosbie Park Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED) Improvement Report has been prepared in response to a request from the Fendalton/Waimairi Community Board meeting dated 17 May 2011. The purpose of the Crosbie Park CPTED Improvement Report is to provide recommendations on how CPTED can assist with the disorder issues that residents living near Crosbie Park are experiencing.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- 2. Residents adjoining Crosbie Park have been experiencing issues regarding anti social behaviour within the confines of the park. They also report that alcohol consumption is an issue amongst youth within the park.
- 3. The attached Crosbie Park CPTED Improvement Report provides a comprehensive overview of the area in question and details the findings and subsequent recommendations of several site visits by the Safer Christchurch Crime Prevention Project Facilitator. The recommendations of the Report primarily cover changes to park maintenance and possible Council enforcement actions over fencing. Key findings in the report include;
 - Identification of five areas of interest within the park.
 - Limited evidence of alcohol consumption.
 - Areas of entrapment and movement predictors.
 - A table of issues and recommended treatments.
- 4. Currently insufficient evidence exists to justify a liquor ban in the area and consultation should be made with Strategy and Planning to assess the viability of a liquor ban by law being implemented in the future.
