


### 3. HAMPSHIRE STREET NEIGHBOURHOOD IMPROVEMENT PLAN



The Roading Projects Consultation Leader sought the approval of the Board to publicise the concept plan for the Hampshire Street Neighbourhood Improvement Plan.

Gail Sheriff moved:

*“That a second Hampshire Street Neighbourhood Plan be distributed as part of the public consultation showing an alternative pedestrian crossing point closer to the Wainoni Park playground.”*

The motion was seconded by Glenda Burt and when put to the meeting was declared **lost** on division number 1 on the casting vote of the Chairperson, by 6 votes to 5, the voting being as follows:

**Against (6):** James, Kellaway, Lea, Rowlands (and the Chairperson’s casting vote), and Williams.

**For (5):** Andrews, Burt, Evans, Hammond, and Sheriff.

The Board **decided:**

1. To approve the Hampshire Street Neighbourhood Improvement Plan for formal consultation.
2. To seek budgetary provision in 2005/06 for additional traffic calming initiatives along the rest of Hampshire Street, including any associated drainage works.
