

8. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

8.1 L.Y.F.E. (Linwood Youth Festival Experience) 2003



Marion Rickerby and youth involved in L.Y.F.E. (Linwood Youth Festival Experience) 2003 presented an overview of L.Y.F.E. to the Board. They also presented a framed photographic montage to the Board showing the history of L.Y.F.E.

The Board thanked the presenters for their work in relation to the festival.

8.2 Sullivan Avenue Residents

Charlotte Green and Ken Molloy addressed the Board regarding issues in Sullivan Avenue and surrounding streets. They presented a petition to the Board signed by approximately 80 people supporting their deputation, and also tabled written submissions and other documentation in support of their deputation.

They submitted that the following issues were of concern:

1. irresponsible driver behaviour, such as high speeds, burnouts and street racing;
2. the poor condition of the road surface, including kerbs, channels and footpaths;
3. recurring problems with blocked drains causing flooding;
4. street parking for Polytech students;
5. poor street lighting; and
6. safety issues at the Ensors Road/Sullivan Avenue intersection.

They submitted that residents have a strong desire to work with the Council to resolve these issues through a living streets consultation process.

The Board thanked Ms Green and Mr Molloy for their presentation and **decided** to seek a report to the Board's Environment and Traffic Committee addressing the issues raised in the deputation and outlining the process for creating a living street.
